

Red Meat Export Statistics

June 2023

Beef and Veal

Trade data for June 2023 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of June:

1. United States – 20,585 tonnes
 - An increase in volume of 2,645 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
2. China – 19,583 tonnes
 - A decrease in volume of 14 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
3. Japan – 18,831 tonnes
 - An decrease in volume of 535 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
4. South Korea – 14,486 tonnes
 - A decrease in volume of 1,162 tonnes when compared to the previous month.

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 18.17% when compared to June 2022 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

Mutton

For mutton in June, our largest monthly shipments were to China with 8,217 tonnes, Malaysia with 1,648 tonnes, the United States with 1,140 tonnes and Singapore with 821 tonnes. Total Australian mutton exports are **up** by 74% compared to June 2022 on a YTD basis.

Lamb

For lamb in June, our largest monthly shipments were to China with 6,394 tonnes, followed by United States with 5,814 tonnes, and South Korea with 2,217 tonnes. Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 60% compared to June 2022 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in June, our largest monthly shipments were to the United States with 1,084 tonnes, China with 651 tonnes and South Korea with 589 tonnes. Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 129% on a YTD basis compared to June 2022.

Pork

For pork in June, our largest monthly shipments were to Singapore with 1,596 tonnes, the Philippines with 401 tonnes, and Papa New Guinea with 283 tonnes. Total Australian pork exports are **up** by 97% on a YTD basis from June 2022.
