Red Meat Export Statistics

July 2023

Beef and Veal

Trade data for July 2023 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of July:

- 1. United States 23,587 tonnes
 - An increase in volume of 3,002 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
- 2. Japan 17,732 tonnes
 - A decrease in volume of 1,099 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
- 3. South Korea 16,960 tonnes
 - An increase in volume of 2,474 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
- 4. China 16,807 tonnes
 - A decrease in volume of 2,776 tonnes when compared to the previous month.

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 22% when compared to July 2022 on a year-todate (YTD) basis.

Mutton

For mutton in July, our largest monthly shipments were to China with 5,360 tonnes, Malaysia with 1,249 tonnes, Singapore with 618 tonnes, and the United States with 815 tonnes. Total Australian mutton exports are **up** by 53% compared to July 2022 on a YTD basis.

Lamb

For lamb in July, our largest monthly shipments were to the United States with 6,066 tonnes, followed by China with 5,590 tonnes, and South Korea with 2,188 tonnes. Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 8% compared to July 2022 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in July, our largest monthly shipments were to the United States with 1,243 tonnes, South Korea with 808 tonnes and China with 362 tonnes. Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 46% on a YTD basis compared to July 2022.

Pork

For pork in July, our largest monthly shipments were to Singapore with 1,596 tonnes, the Philippines with 401 tonnes, and Papua New Guinea with 283 tonnes. Total Australian pork exports are **up** by 25% on a YTD basis from July 2022.
