

## Red Meat Export Statistics

October 2023

### Beef and Veal

Trade data for October 2023 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of October:

1. United States – 27,527 tonnes
  - An increase in volume of 3,130 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
2. China – 19,675 tonnes
  - An increase in volume of 624 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
3. South Korea – 17,502 tonnes
  - An increase in volume of 1,039 tonnes when compared to the previous month.
4. Japan – 16,563 tonnes
  - An increase in volume of 287 tonnes when compared to the previous month.

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 44% when compared to October 2022 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

### Mutton

For mutton in October, our largest monthly shipments were to China with 10,195 tonnes, Malaysia with 1,689 tonnes, the United States with 1,332 tonnes, and Singapore with 618 tonnes. Total Australian mutton exports are **up** by 51% compared to October 2022 on a YTD basis.

### Lamb

For lamb in October, our largest monthly shipments were to China with 6,038 tonnes followed by the United States with 5,608 tonnes, and Papua New Guinea with 2,081 tonnes. Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 17% compared to October 2022 on a YTD basis.

### Goatmeat

For goatmeat in October, our largest monthly shipments were to the United States with 1,977 tonnes, South Korea with 606 tonnes and China with 574 tonnes. Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 105% on a YTD basis compared to October 2022.

### Pork

For pork in October, our largest monthly shipments were to Singapore with 1,570 tonnes, the Philippines with 525 tonnes, and Papua New Guinea with 238 tonnes. Total Australian pork exports are **up** by 88% on a YTD basis from October 2023.
