

Red Meat Export Statistics

November 2023

Beef and Veal

Trade data for November 2023 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of November:

1. United States 19,470 tonnes
2. South Korea 18,117 tonnes
3. Japan 17,857 tonnes
4. China 16,206 tonnes

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **down** by 11% when compared to November 2022 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

Lamb

For lamb in November, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 6,167 tonnes
2. China 5,057 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 2,188 tonnes

Total Australian lamb exports are **down** by 2% compared to November 2022 on a YTD basis.

Mutton

For mutton in November, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. China 10,363 tonnes
2. Malaysia 1,631 tonnes
3. United States 1,244 tonnes
4. Singapore 951 tonnes

Total Australian mutton exports are **down** by 1.7% compared to November 2022 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in November, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 1,496 tonnes
2. South Korea 388 tonnes
3. China 686 tonnes

Total Australian goatmeat exports are **down** by 22% on a YTD basis compared to November 2022.

Pork

For pork in November, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. Singapore 1,526 tonnes
2. Philippines 256 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 339 tonnes

Total Australian pork exports are **down** by 5.4% on a YTD basis from November 2023.
