

Red Meat Export Statistics

January 2024

Beef and Veal

Trade data for January 2024 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of January:

1. United States 20,308 tonnes
2. Japan 16,331 tonnes
3. China 14,100 tonnes
4. South Korea 11,682 tonnes

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 47% when compared to January 2023 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

Lamb

For lamb in January, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 5,659 tonnes
2. China 3,558 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 1,768 tonnes

Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 38% compared to January 2023 on a YTD basis.

Mutton

For mutton in January, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. China 6,358 tonnes
2. United States 1,961 tonnes
3. Malaysia 1,709 tonnes
4. Singapore 683 tonnes

Total Australian mutton exports are **up** by 25% compared to January 2023 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in January, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 1,337 tonnes
2. South Korea 346 tonnes
3. China 270 tonnes

Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 127% on a YTD basis compared to January 2023.

Pork

For pork in January, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. Singapore 1,754 tonnes
2. Philippines 323 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 253 tonnes

Total Australian pork exports are **up** by 88% on a YTD basis from January 2023.
