

## Red Meat Export Statistics

February 2024

### Beef and Veal

Trade data for February 2024 confirms that Japan was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of February:

1. Japan 23,794 tonnes
2. United States 21,341 tonnes
3. China 15,757 tonnes
4. South Korea 13,869 tonnes

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 69% when compared to February 2023 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

### Lamb

For lamb in February, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 7,529 tonnes
2. China 5,215 tonnes
3. Dubai 2,311 tonnes

Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 36% compared to February 2023 on a YTD basis.

### Mutton

For mutton in February, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. China 6,639 tonnes
2. Malaysia 3,339 tonnes
3. United States 1,805 tonnes
4. Singapore 1,218 tonnes

Total Australian mutton exports are **up** by 37% compared to February 2023 on a YTD basis.

### Goatmeat

For goatmeat in February, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 2,149 tonnes
2. South Korea 690 tonnes
3. China 313 tonnes

Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 92% on a YTD basis compared to February 2023.

### Pork

For pork in February, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. Singapore 1,597 tonnes
2. Philippines 394 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 94 tonnes

Total Australian pork exports are **up** by 69% on a YTD basis from February 2023.
