

Red Meat Export Statistics

March 2024

Beef and Veal

Trade data for March 2024 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of March:

1. United States 26,446 tonnes
2. Japan 21,007 tonnes
3. China 16,484 tonnes
4. South Korea 14,946 tonnes

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 8% when compared to March 2023 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

Lamb

For lamb in March, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 7,366 tonnes
2. China 4,521 tonnes
3. Dubai 2,570 tonnes

Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 22% compared to March 2023 on a YTD basis.

Mutton

For mutton in March, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. China 5,990 tonnes
2. Malaysia 2,905 tonnes
3. United States 1,908 tonnes
4. Singapore 1,161 tonnes

Total Australian mutton exports are **down** by 6% compared to March 2023 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in March, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 2,062 tonnes
2. South Korea 679 tonnes
3. Taiwan 220 tonnes

Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 5% on a YTD basis compared to March 2023.

Pork

For pork in March, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. Singapore 1,562 tonnes
2. Philippines 401 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 186 tonnes

Total Australian pork exports are **up** by 15% on a YTD basis from March 2023.
