

Red Meat Export Statistics

April 2024

Beef and Veal

Trade data for April 2024 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of April:

1. United States 27,224 tonnes
2. Japan 21,731 tonnes
3. South Korea 15,785 tonnes
4. China 14,888 tonnes

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 46% when compared to April 2023 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

Lamb

For lamb in April, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 6,762 tonnes
2. China 5,245 tonnes
3. Dubai 2,189 tonnes

Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 41% compared to April 2023 on a YTD basis.

Mutton

For mutton in April, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. China 4,812 tonnes
2. Malaysia 1,870 tonnes
3. United States 1,860 tonnes
4. Singapore 726 tonnes

Total Australian mutton exports are **up** by 20% compared to April 2023 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in April, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 2,837 tonnes
2. South Korea 763 tonnes
3. China 252 tonnes

Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 95% on a YTD basis compared to April 2023.

Pork

For pork in April, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. Singapore 1,595 tonnes
2. Philippines 570 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 159 tonnes

Total Australian pork exports are **up** by 63% on a YTD basis from April 2023.
