



Red Meat Export Statistics

May 2024

Beef and Veal

Trade data for May 2024 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of May:

1. United States 31,294 tonnes
2. Japan 25,435 tonnes
3. South Korea 17,096 tonnes
4. China 15,359 tonnes

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 25% when compared to May 2023 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

Lamb

For lamb in May, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 8,465 tonnes
2. China 5,219 tonnes
3. Dubai 2,353 tonnes

Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 29% compared to May 2023 on a YTD basis.

Mutton

For mutton in May, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. China 5,363 tonnes
2. Malaysia 2,365 tonnes
3. United States 936 tonnes
4. Singapore 889 tonnes

Total Australian mutton exports are **up** by 11% compared to May 2023 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in May, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 2,893 tonnes
2. South Korea 856 tonnes
3. Taiwan 182 tonnes

Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 63% on a YTD basis compared to May 2023.

Pork

For pork in May, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. Singapore 1,751 tonnes
2. Philippines 470 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 156 tonnes

Total Australian pork exports are **down** by 12% on a YTD basis from May 2023.
