

Update on IRC 6 Issues

- The first meeting of the newly established IRC 6 Logistics and Shipping Issues Committee occurred on Friday 24 May 2024. This meeting was introductory in nature.
- Arnold Pascual (Fulton market Group) was elected as the new IRC 6 Chair. An overview of the history of the AMIC Logistics and Shipping portfolio was provided as well as an overview of the association relationships AMIC holds in the space, and any previous advocacy AMIC had done with these associations.
- Finally, the IRC discussed the key advocacy areas for AMIC to focus on in the logistics and shipping space to suit the needs of members in the current broader economic freight and export landscape.
- Key next steps for the AMIC Logistics and Shipping portfolio:
 - A document is being developed outlining a historical look at the AMIC Logistics and Shipping portfolio, as well as a breakdown of the previous and ongoing advocacy objectives for the industry in the space. This, combined with the views of the IRC 6 on contemporary issues in the space, will form the basis for AMICs advocacy in the space.
