



Red Meat Export Statistics

June 2024

Beef and Veal

Trade data for June 2024 confirms that the United States was the largest market for Australian beef and veal exports for the month. The top four markets for Australian beef and veal exports were as follows for the month of June:

1. United States 28,746 tonnes
2. Japan 25,611 tonnes
3. South Korea 16,088 tonnes
4. China 13,206 tonnes

Total Australian beef and veal exports were **up** by 13% when compared to June 2023 on a year-to-date (YTD) basis.

Lamb

For lamb in June, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 7,529 tonnes
2. China 4,431 tonnes
3. EU 1,738 tonnes

Total Australian lamb exports are **up** by 9% compared to June 2023 on a YTD basis.

Mutton

For mutton in June, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. China 3,086 tonnes
2. Malaysia 1,407 tonnes
3. Singapore 601 tonnes
4. United States 227 tonnes

Total Australian mutton exports are **down** by 11% compared to June 2023 on a YTD basis.

Goatmeat

For goatmeat in June, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. United States 2,205 tonnes
2. South Korea 646 tonnes
3. Taiwan 233 tonnes

Total Australian goatmeat exports are **up** by 33% on a YTD basis compared to June 2023.

Pork

For pork in June, our largest monthly shipments were to:

1. Singapore 1,420 tonnes
2. Philippines 296 tonnes
3. Papua New Guinea 244 tonnes

Total Australian pork exports are **down** by 10% on a YTD basis from June 2023.
